

## District 4 Competitive Playing League D4CYSL Fall 2010 Procedures

1. The home team is listed first on the schedule.
2. Any change to the published schedule **MUST BE APPROVED** by your Division Administrator by email:

3. Games may be postponed only for reasons stated in the District IV Rules. Absence of a referee is not a valid reason for postponing a match (Please refer to Article VIII of the District IV Rules and Procedures). It is the home team's responsibility to notify the Division Administrator and Results Secretary of postponements.
4. All game times and locations for the season need to be posted by September 5. **Home teams must confirm time and location with visiting teams by 8:00 PM Monday before the match if they have changed.** Directions to fields can be found at <http://www.mysoccerleague.com>, or the particular club's website.
5. District IV playing rules state that teams must have dark and light jerseys. The home team will change jerseys in case of a color conflict. The home team should show the courtesy of wearing its club's home (dark) jersey. The visiting team shall wear its club's away (light) jersey.
6. The winning coach (or home coach in the event of a tie) must mail the game card to the Results Secretary by Monday following the match. Both teams must log in to <http://www.mysoccerleague.com> to report/confirm scores. Results Secretary mailing information may be found on that website at the bottom of the schedule page for each division.
7. In order to play, each player must have a properly validated player pass. No pass, no play. No exceptions! Game card stickers can be printed from the template that is listed on the CYSA web site. A link to the template can be found below the rain hot line phone numbers on <http://mysoccerleague.com/>. The template can be printed on **Avery 5168** Labels.
8. In the event a player or coach is sent off by the referee, the referee will mail the player pass, game card, and 24-hour report to the chairman of the disciplinary committee: **Roger Wildensten, 18036 Joseph Drive, Castro Valley, CA 94546-1304.**
9. Medals will be awarded to the first and second place teams. There are no tie-breaking procedures so all teams earning first or second place will be awarded.
10. Standings will be determined by game points earned: Win = 3 points; tie = 1 point; loss = 0 points. Refer to the District IV Procedures for details.
11. All games must be played by Sunday, November 14, 2010 to be included in the standings.
12. The home team is responsible for providing a suitable field, ball, and referees.
